

RESULTS OF MANDATORY STATE TESTING FOR LEAD IN WATER SUPPLY

Every morning before the start of the school day, the custodians run checks of all running water at the school. In addition, all fountains at the school are capped and bottled water is dispensed at a water cooler which is purchased from Polish Spring.

A thorough lead test was conducted throughout the building at Englewood on the Palisades Charter School on April 2, 2016.

This test was done by the custodians at the school under the supervision of the director. Various areas included but not limited to boys and girls bathroom and also teacher's bathroom and utility areas.

The samples were picked up by an independent body and submitted on April 4, 2016 and analyzed April 8, 2016 by Garden State Laboratory Inc.

The results of the test came back showing that the levels listed below were above the allowed 0.15ppb (*particles per billion*).

These areas are only used for the washing of hands and utility instruments.
