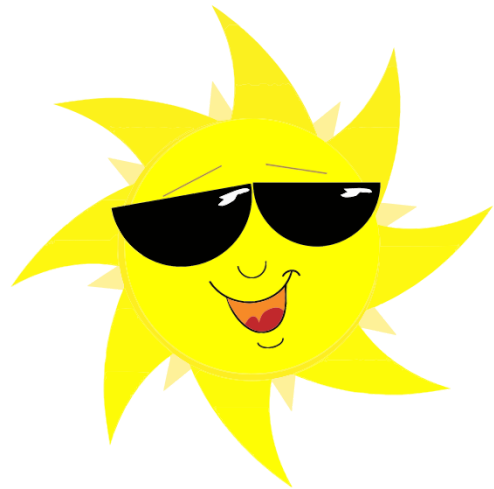

Book Report Grading Rubric

4	Book report was turned in on time Great sentence structure No punctuation, capitalization, or spelling errors Used above level vocabulary Sentences contain many details
3	Book report one day late Good sentence structure Few punctuation, capitalization, or spelling errors Used on or above level vocabulary Sentences contain some details
2	Book report handed in many days late Poor sentence structure Many punctuation, capitalization, or spelling errors Used on level vocabulary Sentences contain few details
1	Book report was not complete / not handed in No sentence structure Many punctuation, capitalization, or spelling errors Used below level vocabulary Sentences contain no detail
